Verticals are sprinkled throughout the list, but the pièce de résistance is the amazing Château Latour "Grand Vin" Vertical Collection 1945-2005 which is available for purchase for MOP 1,300,000!

Play Chopin as you read through the distinct 'movements' of wine styles, though mixing white and red wines in the same section can be a tad confusing. Nonetheless this innovative approach adds fun to this compelling selection of high quality wines.
